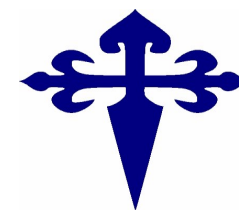

| Most importantly, we have learned how to safely gather to celebrate the Eucharist, the source and summit of the Christian life. The protocols we have put in place are proving effective and there are virtually no cases of viral transmission from Catholic churches gathering for Mass.” |
