











GOSPEL: GOSPEL: St. Mark 1:21-28

Then they came to Capernaum, and on the Sabbath Jesus entered the synagogue and taught. The people were astonished at his teaching, for he taught them as one having authority and not as the scribes. In their synagogue was a man with an unclean spirit; he cried out, "What have you to do with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are—the Holy One of God!" Jesus rebuked him and said, "Quiet! Come out of him!" The unclean spirit convulsed him and with a loud cry came out of him. All were amazed and asked one another, "What is this? A new teaching with authority. He commands even the unclean spirits and they obey him." His fame spread everywhere throughout the whole region of Galilee.

BISHOP KONDERLA has issued a decree, The Normality of Hope: A Word of Encouragement for Participating in the Eucharist.

Here are a few paragraphs:

"...in God's providence...we have learned a great deal about how to live in the midst of this pandemic. We owe a great debt of gratitude to our medical community, our researchers, and essential workers in all circles of society, who have supported us and helped us understand what we now know about this virus and shielded us from the worst of its public effects.

Most importantly, we have learned how to safely gather to celebrate the Eucharist, the source and summit of the Christian life. The protocols we have put in place are proving effective and there are virtually no cases of viral transmission from Catholic churches gathering for Mass."
